Dingo threat to sue over photos

The married TV star has become embroiled in a grubby saga when shots claimed to be of him in the shower were circulated by a woman calling herself "Melissa".

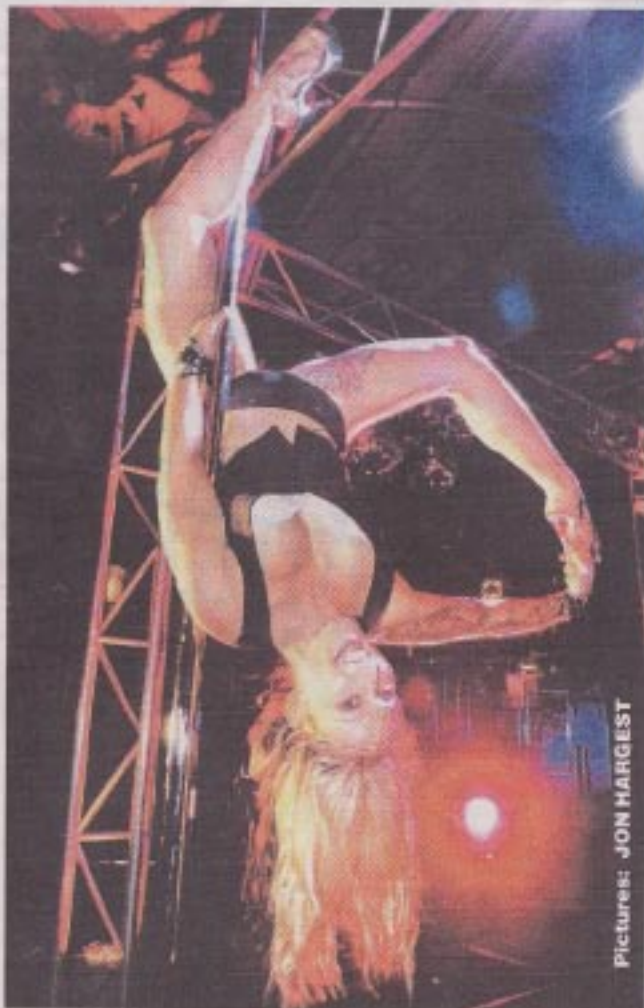
It is believed the woman wanted \$100,000 for the photos, but the magazines have deemed them too graphic for publication.

The former presenter on Channel 7's *Great Outdoors* and father of two refuses to comment on the scandal, and spent yesterday running discussions on indigenous issues at the annual Aboriginal Men's Yarn Up at Wymah, where he told the local paper he didn't consider himself a "role model".

Dingo's spokeswoman said the matter was in the "hands of the lawyers".
